

**NOTICE INVITING BIDS**  
**ANAHEIM UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Anaheim Union High School District, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as "District", will receive prior to **4:00 P.M. P.S.T. ON THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2018** sealed bids for the award of a Contract for the following:

**RFP NO. 2019-10 VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SOLUTION DISTRICT WIDE**

Bids shall be received in the office of the **PURCHASING DEPARTMENT AT 501 CRESCENT WAY, ANAHEIM, CALIFORNIA**, will be reviewed after the proposal submission date, and will not be publicly opened. Any bids received after the time specified above or after any extensions due to material changes shall be returned unopened.

There will be a **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Conference for two consecutive days starting on **SEPTEMBER 26, 2018, 9:00 A.M. P.S.T. at DISTRICT OFFICE, 501 N. CRESCENT WAY, ANAHEIM, CA, IN THE BOARD ROOM.** Please allow enough time for parking. The Pre-Bid Conference will start on time and contractors that arrive after time stated above will not be allowed to attend. Any Contractor bidding on the project who fails to attend the mandatory portion of the Pre-Bid conference will be deemed a non-responsive bidder and will have its bid returned unopened. Site visits will be conducted immediately following the mandatory portion of the Pre-Bid conference. The bid documents will be made available at the Pre-Bid Conference.

Each bidder shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the California Business and Professions Code, and be licensed to perform the work called for in the RFP Documents. The successful bidder must possess a valid and active license as required at the time of award and throughout the duration of this Contract. The Contractor's California State License number shall be clearly stated on the bidder's proposal.

Contractor's Subcontractors shall be licensed pursuant to California law for the trades necessary to perform the work called for in the RFP Documents.

Each bid must strictly conform with and be responsive to the RFP Documents as defined in the General Conditions. No bidder may withdraw any bid for a period of at least ninety (90) calendar days after the date set for the opening of bids.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding.

Separate payment and performance bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the total Contract amount, are required, and shall be provided to the District prior to execution of the Contract and shall be in the form set forth in the RFP Documents.

All bonds (Bid, Performance, and Payment) must be issued by a California admitted surety as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure section 995.120.

Each proposer shall be a licensed contractor pursuant to the Business and Professions Code and shall be licensed in the following appropriate classification of contractor's license, **B, C-7, or C-10**, for the work proposed upon, and must maintain the license throughout the duration of the Contract.

The District has obtained the prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holiday and overtime work applicable in this locality from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations for each craft, classification, or type of workman need to execute this contract and has a copy of these prevailing rates on file at its office. Any interested party may request a copy or obtain the information from [www.dir.ca.gov](http://www.dir.ca.gov). The successful proposer shall post a copy thereof at each job site. District hereby

places the Contractor and any subcontractors on notice of the penalty provisions of Labor Code Section 1775 for failure to comply with prevailing wage laws. No proposals shall be accepted from a contractor who is ineligible pursuant to Labor Code Sections 1777.1 and 1777.7.

Contractors, and their subcontractors, shall be properly registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and qualified to perform public works in accordance with Labor Code sections 1725.5 and 1771.1, otherwise the District will not be able to award a contract to the contractor. The project will be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR.
