9TH GRADE

ACADEMIC PLANNING

- ↓ All students entering 9th grade will participate in a transition program to help them get to know their new school.
- ↓ Students will revisit, and update the 6-year plan consisting of the classes required to graduate from high school and the A-G classes required to apply to four-year public universities.
- ↓ Students will be provided with support to earn a C grade or better in all classes.
- ↓ Students will be provided with opportunities to complete 10 hours of civic learning required for graduation.
- ↓ Students will be introduced to the Capstone project and the planning stages will begin in 9th grade.
- ↓ Strong focus on: Critical thinking, Collaboration, Creativity, Communication, and Character (Five "C"s)
- ↓ All students will write as a tool for learning in all their classes.

COLLEGE & CAREER PLANNING

- ↓ Students will be encouraged to visit a 4-year college or university.
- ↓ Students will complete an autobiographical essay that can be used for college applications and scholarships.
- ↓ All students will be invited to attend the Anaheim Union High School District College and Career Fair in October.
- ↓ Students will learn about opportunities offered through the Anaheim Innovative Mentoring Experience (AIME) and work-based learning.
- ↓ Students will participate in a guidance lesson on a social emotional topic.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

- ↓ Parents will have an opportunity to review the 6-year plan and work with the school counselor to make any adjustments.
- ↓ Parents will be invited to participate in workshops about college, and planning your future.
- ↓ Parents will be invited to participate in the Parent Leadership Academy 1.0 (8 week course) or 2.0 to learn how to best support their child in school and prepare for college.
- ↓ Parents will be invited to attend Parent Learning Walks to learn about how to support their child's learning.
