1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit). In 2023-2024, Anaheim Union High School District utilized Arts and Music in Schools (AMS) funding to expand arts education at all campuses. Certificated teachers taught additional sections in Guitar and Dance Production and also provided arts education program instruction across the District. 107 new classified employees were hired as Arts Professional Experts and worked as hourly employees as needed to supplement and enhance arts education at every campus in the District. The Arts Professional Experts worked as teaching artists, coaches in instrumental music, vocal music, and dance as well as providing technical theater instruction. These classified employees worked a total of 13,156 hours over four monthly pay periods since the AMS funding became available in February. Funding was also used for musical instruments, sheet music, art supplies, and supplemental materials for courses in all arts disciplines.
