



# Pathway to Biliteracy Awards

**Objective:** Recognize students exiting the 8<sup>th</sup> grade for their academic achievement in language (reading, writing, and speaking).

The Pathway to Biliteracy Awards are designed to provide recognition for students who have a heritage language, take world language courses or are in a dual language immersion program. The Pathway to Biliteracy Award encourages students to continue their biliteracy and multiliteracy to attain the **Seal of Biliteracy** in twelfth grade.

Can you read, write, understand and speak in another language? Do you want to earn a ribbon to wear at 8th grade awards night and be on the Pathway to earning the Seal of Biliteracy when you graduate high school?

### **Requirements:**

1. Met or exceeded on the ELA portion of SBAC
2. 2.0 GPA or higher in ELA courses
3. Ability to write coherently and with purpose in the two languages of instruction
4. Attend two cultural events and write a reflection on each, one written in English and the other written in the other language.

# OCDE Award Requirements

## *Medal and award*

### THE ORANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION **PATHWAY TO BILITERACY AWARD**

Can you read, write, understand and speak in another language? Do you want to earn a medal to wear at 8th grade awards night and be on the Pathway to earning the Seal of Biliteracy when you graduate high school?

#### **Requirements:**

1. "Proficient" or higher level on district grade level benchmark assessment
2. ELPAC overall score of 4 for students who are English Learners.
3. Age appropriate oral/listening proficiency in another language based on teacher assessment and observation
4. Reading Log which includes a minimum of 10 book titles for both the target language and English
5. Documentation of Active use of both English and another language. Students may demonstrate these skills by serving as bilingual ambassadors for visitors to the school, reading books to younger students, or other specific tasks authorized by the student's classroom teacher
6. Oral Presentation on grade level content in both English and another language
7. Argumentative essays, written on both English and another language

### THE SEAL OF BILITERACY

*The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by the Anaheim Union High School District in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation. Appearing on the transcript of the graduating senior, the Seal of Biliteracy is a statement of accomplishment for future employers and for college admissions. **The journey begins at Orangeview.***



### How can you get the seal?

#### Begin with the Pathway Awards

A student **must be able to** demonstrate proficiency in reading, writing, and speaking in English and another language.
